

**"DICK SCHAAP"
EXCELLENCE IN SPORTS JOURNALISM AWARD**



Northeastern University's *Center for the Study of Sport in Society* and the *NU School of Journalism* have collaborated to make Northeastern the first university in the nation to recognize sports journalists with awards of distinction. The awards, created in 1986, honor journalists or works of journalism which address some element of human, sociological or societal impact of sport on American life. Through its *Excellence in Sports Journalism Awards*, *Sport in Society* and the *NU School of Journalism* honor journalistic achievements that enhance our understanding of the impact of sport on our culture. Categories include Print/Online Media and Broadcast Media.

In 2002, the *Excellence in Sports Journalism Award* was re-named after the late Dick Schaap, a 1987 awards winner. Over a half-century Dick Schaap's journalism embodied the values Northeastern seeks to recognize, writing on the people and issues in sport with insight, energy, and compassion in the *New York Herald Tribune*, *Sport Magazine*, on three different television networks and in more than 30 books. He was also a tremendous friend to Northeastern University and the *Center for the Study of Sport in Society*, serving as master of ceremonies at *Sport in Society's* annual *True Heroes of Sport* awards banquet for 10 years.
